




Hope Herald Appreciation from Ghana

The President's View

GIVING WITH PURPOSE

I can't speak for other countries, but Americans are generous people! In 2010 more than **290 Billion** was contributed to charities in the United States. 80% of that giving was done by individuals.

In II Corinthians 9:7 Paul writes, "Everyone should give as he purposes in his heart." Purpose shows intent, motive, and discipline. It shows you've given careful thought to your giving.

Paul's command to give purposefully acknowledges you have many choices. Like mine, your mailbox brings you many appeals. How do you decide which organizations to support? What is the purpose of your giving? What do you want it to accomplish?

The Old Testament tithe had three basic purposes that have continuing significance and application for us. First, the tithe was to support the "spiritual leaders;" Leviticus 27, Deuteronomy 14, and I Corinthians 9. The tithe was also gathered to feed the widows and orphans of the Hebrew society as well as the non-Jewish poor living in the community, Deuteronomy 14 and Galatians 6:10.

The biblical principal is that your first-fruits belong to your local church. Giving to other ministries should be offerings above that.

Your support for other organizations must be given cautiously. Know what they believe and how they flesh out that belief in ministry. Many well-meaning Christians support organizations like "International Fellowship of Christians and Jews." They are unaware that Rabbi Eckstein, leader of IFCJ believes "The rejection of Jesus as Messiah is the key to Jewish survival." Because of this, a significant amount of funds raised from Christians goes to organizations who promote 'anti-missionary' activity.

You should also be extremely careful about donating money to secular groups or causes. I've learned this the hard way. In the past I made a few donations to the National Wildlife Federation. That was until I discovered that they support China's one-child, forced abortion policy. Many environmental groups, focusing on animals, wilderness, or whatever, support population control. Be careful and do your homework well lest you make the same mistake I did.

As you exercise the grace of giving, give purposefully. Be generous, be systematic, be disciplined, and be careful.

RAGS VERSUS RICHES

I was recently challenged by a devotional I read with the above title. One statement made was that our lives are likely to be more effective for God if we have "neither riches nor poverty." It was based on Prov. 30:8b-9, "Give me neither poverty or riches; feed me with food convenient for me: Lest I be full, and deny thee, and say, Who is the Lord? or lest I be poor, and steal, and take the name of my God in vain."

Having riches can tend to give us the false impression that we don't need God. Also, that if we are poor we are tempted to steal, blame God, or even become bitter at Him.

At times we are tempted to imagine that more money would make our lives better, easier, and solve a lot of life's problems. However, I Tim. 6:9-10 says, "But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition. For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows."

Therefore, we need to learn to be a faithful steward of money and God's many blessings to us whether we have little or plenty. Strive to be like Paul in Philippians 4:11-12; "Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content. I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: everywhere and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need."


