APRIL

Tue. 16th: Praise God for the many strategic partners of HOH. Pray His blessing on our breakfast meeting in Middleburg, PA to update them on the results of their partnership.

Wed. 17th: Pray for the HOH team and Pastor Anand at the East District Mennonite Church this evening. Pray attendees will be encouraged to hear what God is doing in Nepal.

Thu. 18th: Thank God for our partners in the Lewisburg, PA area. Pray our breakfast guests will be blessed and challenged by Pastor Anand's report of the growing church in Nepal.

Fri. 19th: Ask God to bless Messianic Believers in Israel with endurance as they testify of Jesus the Messiah in spite of harassment and opposition.

Sat. 20th: Pray for wisdom and fairness among our ministry partners in Africa as they distribute the Bibles they received through HOH last year.

Sun. 21st: Thank God for the reality of the Resurrection! Rejoice in the power of the Holy Spirit in your life as He leads, guides, and equips you for service.

Thu. 25th: Praise God for the desire and power He gives us to do what we know is right. Commit yourself to obey the initial prompting of the Holy Spirit for your continuing victory.

Fri. 26th: Ask God to bless our daily Hindi language programs to northern India. Pray Holy Spirit boldness for the production team in Jharkhand state as they produce our programs.

Sat. 27th: Rejoice in the privilege you have to fellowship with other Believers tomorrow and pray that God will use your joy to encourage those who are struggling with life's adversities.

Sun. 28th: Pray that listeners to our Amharic language program to Ethiopia will understand the need to be born again. Pray they will experience the liberating power of the Gospel.

Mon. 29th: Praise God for the compassion and forgiveness He has extended to you. Commit yourself to extend these same gifts to those who have offended or hurt you.

Tue. 30th: Obey the Biblical injunction to pray for "kings and all those in authority" and steadfastly intercede for government leaders "that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness."

Wed. 1st: Rejoice in the new members of our HOH family! Thank God He is raising up more and younger donors to continue praying for and funding His work through this ministry.

Thu. 2nd: Pray that our Hope for Today programs aired from Equatorial Guinea to West Africa tomorrow night will renew the hope and spiritual vitality of many listeners.

Fri. 3rd: Praise God for the gifts and abilities He's given you and use them for His glory and the blessing of others. Accept each task as an assignment from Him and devote all your energies to it.

Sat. 4th: Pray for Shema Media in Turkey as they continue expanding the reach of the Gospel! Praise God for Bro. Soner and the team, using multiple platforms to share the Word of God.

Sun. 5th: Rejoice in the continuing "GO" of the Gospel! Pray the Lord of the Harvest to send forth more workers into His fields that are ripe and ready for reaping.

Mon. 6th: PRAYER AND FASTING

Tue. 7th: Ask God to help you be like the "noble" Bereans of Acts 17:11. Make sure the teaching and preaching you endorse does not violate the letter or the spirit of Scripture.

Wed. 8th: Rejoice in the ministry of comfort provided by the Holy Spirit. Allow God to use you as a channel through which that comfort can flow out to others who are hurting.

Thu. 9th: Pray for all Christians to see the importance of commitment to a local church fellowship. Pray especially for Believers who live in areas of the world where this is very difficult.

Fri. 10th: Praise God for those whose Christian walk matches their talk! Ask God to help you be transparent in your motives and actions, especially in your relationships with the unsaved.

Sat. 11th: Ask God to help you live with the constant anticipation of the return of Jesus Christ! Pray that reality will stimulate your desire to share the Gospel with those around you.

Sun. 12th: Bless God for your mother's care and kindness to you. Pray that Christian women would accept motherhood as a high and noble calling in a culture that denigrates the role.

Mon. 13th: Ask God to sharpen your sensitivity to the needs of those around you, both of Believers and the unsaved. Pray He will show you how to be His hands and feet to show His love.

Tue. 14th: Cry out to God on behalf of our suffering brothers and sisters in northern Nigeria! Recent violence has left many dead and injured, and many more homeless and destitute.

Wed. 15th: Praise God for our partnership with Media 7 in Albania! Thank God for the churches and individuals who provide funds for this vital ministry reaching Muslims with the Gospel and encouraging Believers.

Thu. 16th: Your Christian home has potential for witness to the lost. Ask God to give you opportunities to use hospitality to point others to the Savior.

Fri. 17th: Praise God for English HOPE messages from Guam to southern India and Nigeria today. Praise God for the testimonies we receive of changed lives!

Sat. 18th: Ask the Father to give us wisdom as we implement a new donor management software. We want to use changing technology for effective ministry and the glory of God.

Dear Praying Partners:

The Bible introduces Stephen to us in Acts 6 as one of the seven deacons chosen to minister in the church. Because of his faithfulness, God entrusted him with greater responsibility and authority. His ministry attracted the attention of the enemy, Satan, working through the religious leaders of the day. They could not deny the power of God, nor refute the miracles that were performed, so they conspired to put him to death.

The hatred these men had for Stephen still holds sway in the hearts of many people who inhabit the Middle East. Our broadcasts to this area strengthen and encourage Believers. We must be faithful in praying for them (Hebrews 13:3).
