APRIL

Thu. 16th: Praise God for thousands of HOPE Bibles being distributed in 2020. Pray wisdom and grace for our ministry partners who must make the distribution decisions locally.

Fri. 17th: Beseech God to bring an end to the Covid-19 pandemic! So many people in under-developed countries are desperately poor and unable to cope with extended quarantines.

Sat. 18th: Intercede for the people of Nepal. Since India has quarantined all its citizens, food, fuel, and other necessities have become difficult to acquire in Nepal--a landlocked country.

Sun. 19th: Rejoice with Chandrika in the hope he's found in Jesus. Pray that God will use his changed life to point his Hindu family to Jesus.

Mon. 20th: Continue praying for our suffering brothers and sisters in China. Bless God we can minister to them via our Mandarin language program from Guam tonight.

Tue. 21st: Ask God for patience amid the current restrictions on travel and movement. Realize your choices may affect others in unforeseen ways!

Wed. 22nd: Praise God for the compassion and forgiveness He's extended to you. Commit yourself to extend the same to those who have offended you.

Thu. 23rd: Ask God to provide for the financial needs of HOH during this time of uncertainty. We truly depend on His grace and your financial support.

Fri. 24th: Thank God for His many gifts! Ask Him to help you experience His promise that "godliness with contentment is great gain."

Sat. 25th: Pray that many prison inmates will be able to hear our radio broadcasts. Covid-19 restrictions are preventing many chaplains and outside organizations from normal ministry.

Sun. 26th: Praise God for the desire and power He gives us to do what is right. Obey the initial promptings of the Holy Spirit for your continuing victory.

Mon. 27th: Ask the Father to bless listeners to our daily Hindi language programs to northern India. Pray for the relief of tensions that are very high in this part of the country.

Tue. 28th: Praise God that many listeners to our Hausa language program in Nigeria are finding HOPE in Jesus! In the most recent calendar quarter, 88 persons testified of salvation.

Wed. 29th: Rejoice in God's sovereign power and knowledge of all things! Thank Him that He's never surprised by our circumstances like we are.

Thu. 30th: Bless God for opportunities during this pandemic to help others. Ask God to give you creativity and wisdom in sharing Jesus' love.

MAY

Fri. 1st: Thank God for print and electronic resources we can use to stay in touch with our HOPE Family! Please share these resources and information with others.

Sat. 2nd: Obey the command to pray for “kings and all those in authority.” Intercede for government leaders “that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness.”

Sun. 3rd: Praise God for the gifts and abilities He’s given you. Be committed to using them for His glory and the blessing of others in your church and local community.

Mon. 4th: PRAYER AND FASTING

Tue. 5th: Rejoice with us in our continuing partnership with Shema Media in Turkey. Thank God for the many listeners who are being connected with local churches for discipleship.

Wed. 6th: Ask God to help you be like the “noble” Bereans of Acts 17:11. Make sure the teaching and preaching you hear does not violate the context or the spirit of Scripture.

Thu. 7th: Pray that our “Hope for Today” programs aired from Equatorial Guinea to West Africa tomorrow night will renew the hope and spiritual vitality of many listeners, as they too wrestle with the affects of COVID-19.

Fri. 8th: Rejoice in the ministry of comfort provided by the Holy Spirit. Allow God to use you as a channel through which that comfort can flow out to others who are hurting.

Sat. 9th: Pray for all Christ-followers to see the importance of commitment and involvement with a local church. Pray especially for those who live where this is very difficult.

Sun. 10th: Bless God for your mother’s care and kindness to you. Pray that Christian women would accept motherhood as a high and noble calling in a culture that denigrates the role.

Mon. 11th: Ask God to help you live with the constant anticipation of the return of Jesus Christ! Pray that anticipation will stimulate your desire to share the Gospel with those around you.

Tue. 12th: Praise God for those whose Christian walk matches their talk! Ask God to help you be transparent in both motives and actions in your dealings with your fellow man.

Wed. 13th: Pray God to impress upon every Believer the need for a discerning spirit in our age of much error! Ask the Holy Spirit to protect you from the trickery of the enemy, Satan.

Thu. 14th: Praise God our Spanish language broadcasts have been on the air since 1987! Pray for translator, Daniel James, and for the thousands of listeners that hear the program weekly.

Fri. 15th: Seek wisdom for the HOH Board as they consider the millions of unreached in Central Asia. This area of the world (Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Kazakhstan, etc.) has much persecution and very little Gospel radio.

Sat. 16th: “Praise ye the Lord. I will praise the Lord with my whole heart, in the assembly of the upright, and in the congregation.” Psalm 111:1

Sun. 17th: Pray for our twice-weekly broadcasts to North Korea. Pray God’s mercy and sustaining grace for Believers in Jesus, and pray they’ll experience His presence in unusual ways.

Mon. 18th: Praise God for the amazing growth of the Church in Iran! Reports indicate a massive disciple-making movement is sweeping across this theocratic, Muslim country.

Tue. 19th: Ask the Father to provide the funds for our next order of HOPE Bibles. Since our Spring PR programs were cancelled, we had to postpone placing the order for 30,000 copies.

Wed. 20th: Bless God for the ministry of Equipping the Saints, in Weyer’s Cave, VA. They connect Christian resources in North America with evangelical ministries around the world.

Thu. 21st: Ask God to sharpen your sensitivity to the needs of those around you, both of Believers and the unsaved. Pray He’ll show you how to be His hands and feet in demonstrating His love.

Fri. 22nd: Praise God for a family business that sponsors our Pashto language programs to Afghanistan and Pakistan. Pray God will bless and prosper this family for their generosity.

Sat. 23rd: Pray for persecuted Believers in Sudan. Recently, two church buildings were burned: one in Blue Nile State, and one in Omdurman.

Sun. 24th: Bless God for the High family continuing their plans to move to Harrisonville this summer. Pray His blessing upon them as they face the adjustments that accompany this move.

Mon. 25th: Pray for Messianic Believers in Israel providing food, clothing, and other practical help to the poor. Praise God for the doors this opens to sharing the Gospel.

Tue. 26th: Praise God, He is our Rock and our Fortress! Though all around us seems to be shaking, He remains unshaken, and surrounds us with His protection and love.

Wed. 27th: Pray Spirit anointing on our Albanian language broadcasts. Thank God for our partnership with Media 7 that enables many to hear the Gospel on their radio and TV network.

Thu. 28th: Praise God for the many Indonesian Muslims coming to faith in Jesus! Pastor Peter says, “receiving permission from the local government for the 2 congregations is a miracle.”

Fri. 29th: Intercede for the hundreds of thousands of refugees around the world. Many live in squalid camps where lack of sanitation and clean water make them vulnerable to disease and death.

Sat. 30th: Praise God for the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost! Renew your commitment to obey the daily direction He gives you through the Word and your conscience.

Sun. 31st: Ask God to bless those who have remembered HOH in their wills and/or estate plans. Thank Him for those who use their resources to continue their legacy after their departure.

The Bible introduces Stephen to us in Acts 6 as one of the seven deacons chosen to minister in the church. Because of his faithfulness, God entrusted him with greater responsibility and authority.

His ministry attracted the attention of the enemy, Satan, working through the religious leaders of the day. They could not deny the power of God nor refute the miracles that were performed, so they conspired to put him to death.

The hatred these men had for Stephen still holds sway in the hearts of many people who inhabit the Middle East. Our broadcasts to this area strengthen and encourage Believers. We must be faithful in praying for them (Hebrews 13:3).
