APRIL

Fri. 16th: Pray God’s blessing on our PR events today in Middlebury, IN and Plain City, OH. Pray that God will be glorified, and people will be encouraged as we share these ministry updates.

Sat. 17th: Thank God for those who gather for our HOH brunch in Walnut Creek, OH today. God is doing amazing things, and we look forward to inviting more people to participate in His work!

Sun. 18th: Pray God to impress upon every Believer the need for a discerning spirit in our age of much error! Ask the Holy Spirit to protect you.

Mon. 19th: Bless God for the *Hope for Today* broadcast via shortwave from WWCR Nashville, TN to Africa tomorrow. Praise Him these programs are helping to disciple Believers!

Tue. 20th: Pray for suffering brothers and sisters in China and bless God that we can minister to them via our Mandarin-language program from Guam.

Wed. 21st: Praise God for the 57,000 Bibles distributed by HOH in 2020! We thank God for the partnerships He’s opening for us with Bible suppliers and with distributors, too.

Thu. 22nd: Obey the Biblical injunction to pray for “kings and all those in authority . . . that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness . . .”

Fri. 23rd: Thank God for His many gifts to you! Ask Him to help you develop a grateful spirit as you reflect on the truth of Scripture that “godliness with contentment is great gain.”

Sat. 24th: Ask the Father to use the 57 releases of *The Voice of Hope* in North America this weekend to give listeners a better understanding of Jesus through Bro. J. Mark’s teaching from Colossians.

Sun. 25th: Praise God for the desire and power He gives us to do what we know is right. Commit yourself to obey the initial prompting of the Holy Spirit for your continuing victory.

Mon. 26th: Pray God’s blessing and wisdom on prison chaplains and volunteers sharing with inmates the forgiveness and healing available through a relationship with Jesus.

Tue. 27th: Praise God for the compassion and forgiveness He’s extended to you. Commit yourself to extend the same graces to those who have offended or hurt you.

Wed. 28th: Pray that listeners to our Amharic and Oromo language programs to Ethiopia will understand the need to be born again and will know the liberating power of the Gospel.

Thu. 29th: Praise God for the gifts and abilities He’s given to you and commit to using them for His glory and the blessing of others. Accept each task as a special assignment from Him.

Fri. 30th: Ask the Father to bless Messianic Believers in Israel with endurance as they faithfully testify of the Messiah in spite of harassment and opposition from Orthodox Judaism.

MAY

Sat. 1st: Rejoice in the privilege you have to fellowship with other Believers tomorrow and pray that God will use your joy to encourage those who are struggling with life's adversities.

Sun. 2nd: Pray that our Bible teaching programs aired to Central Asia will impact many with HOPE. Praise God for generous individuals and churches who make this outreach possible.

Mon. 3rd: PRAYER AND FASTING

Tue. 4th: Rejoice in the ministry of comfort provided by the Holy Spirit. Allow God to use you as a channel through which that comfort can flow out to others who are hurting.

Wed. 5th: Pray for the effectiveness of our new programs in North Macedonia. Ask God to bless the staff of Radio 7 as they translate, produce, and air the programs, as well as provide follow-up.

Thu. 6th: Praise God for our Pashto language programs to Pakistan and Afghanistan. Though we have little open response to these, God has promised His Word will accomplish its purpose!

Fri. 7th: Ask God to help you be like the "noble" Bereans of Acts 17:11. Make sure the teaching and preaching you hear does not violate the letter or the spirit of Scripture.

Sat. 8th: Pray for all Christians to see the importance of active involvement with a local church fellowship. Pray especially for Believers who live in areas of the world where this is very difficult.

Sun. 9th: Bless God for your mother's care and kindness to you. Pray that women will accept motherhood as a high and noble calling in a culture that often denigrates the role.

Mon. 10th: Ask God to help you live with the constant anticipation of the return of Jesus Christ! Pray that reality will stimulate your desire to share the Gospel with those around you.

Tue. 11th: Praise God for the increasing flood of responses to our twice-weekly Hausa language programs! Thank Him for the many testimonies of suffering Believers who are being encouraged.

Wed. 12th: Ask God to sharpen your sensitivity to the needs of those around you, both of Believers and the unsaved. Pray He'll show you how to be His hands and feet to show His love.

Thu. 13th: Bless God for Equipping the Saints, in Weyer's Cave, VA. They provide Bibles, Christian literature, and other supplies for evangelical ministries around the world.

Fri. 14th: Seek Spirit blessing on the staff of Shema Media in Turkey who produce our Turkish programming. Pray for their physical safety and for the increasing effectiveness of their ministry.

Sat. 15th: Praise God for those whose Christian walk matches their talk! Ask God to help you be transparent in motives and actions in your dealings with your fellow man.

Sun. 16th: Pray for thousands of Kenyan Christians facing a huge, new locust invasion. Coupled with the 2020 locust plague, many are facing the complete loss of crops and foodstuffs.

Mon. 17th: Thank God for attendees at our SPB* in Myerstown, PA tomorrow morning. Seek God's blessing on them as we report how their partnership is bringing HOPE to many around the world.

Tue. 18th: Ask God to bless attendees at our SPB* in McAlisterville, PA tomorrow morning. Thank God we can encourage them by the impact their partnership has had in touching lives with HOPE.

Wed. 19th: Thank God for attendees at our SPB* in Belleville, PA tomorrow morning. Seek God's blessing on them as we report how their partnership is bringing HOPE to many around the world.

Thu. 20th: Ask God to bless attendees at our SPB* in Lancaster, PA tomorrow morning. Thank God we can encourage them by the impact their partnership has had in touching lives with HOPE.

Tue. 25th: Thank God for our daily Guarani programs in Paraguay! Pray Spirit blessing on RTM (Radio Trans Mundial) staff translating and producing our programs to stations.

Wed. 26th: Pray Spirit anointing on our Hindi and Telugu language programs to India. Praise God for the impact they're having in both evangelism and discipleship.

Thu. 27th: Praise God for English HOPE messages from Guam to southern India tomorrow. Praise God for the testimonies we receive of changed lives for the glory of God!

Fri. 28th: Pray for the HOH Board as they continue to monitor the effects of the ministry and guide its growth. Thank God for these eight dedicated men and their families.

Sat. 29th: Thank God for the impact of our Arabic language programs to the Middle East, N. Africa, and Europe. Praise Him for the many Muslims who are embracing faith in Jesus Christ!

The Bible introduces Stephen to us in Acts 6 as one of the seven deacons chosen to minister in the church. Because of his faithfulness, God entrusted him with greater responsibility and authority.

His ministry attracted the attention of the enemy, Satan, working through the religious leaders of the day. They could not deny the power of God nor refute the miracles that were performed, so they conspired to put him to death.

The hatred these men had for Stephen still holds sway in hearts of many people who inhabit the Middle East. Our Arabic broadcasts to this area strengthen and encourage Believers. We must be faithful in praying for them (Hebrews 13:3).

Read and meditate on Acts 6:1-15, then join us to

Praise God for:

- committed, courageous Believers.
- radio beams penetrating closed areas.
- Muslim imams turning to Christ.
